

1. Discussion and finalization of the course structure of B.Tech 4<sup>th</sup> year (R19) and B.Tech 3<sup>rd</sup> year (R20).
2. DrG.Yesuratnam, Professor & Nominee, JNTUK has suggested the changes in "Advanced Structural Analysis" course. He has also advised some changes in DARCS especially with the contents of water tanks and bridge designs.
3. DrS.R.K. Reddy, the expert on OBEmphasized the importance of blooms taxonomy and CO-PO mapping. He also suggested to incorporate the design aspects for both RCC and Steel Structures courses separately and test the students accordingly.
4. Dr P.Gandhi, Scientist, SERC has emphasized to introduce industry related software and coding courses in the curriculum for the benefit of students.
